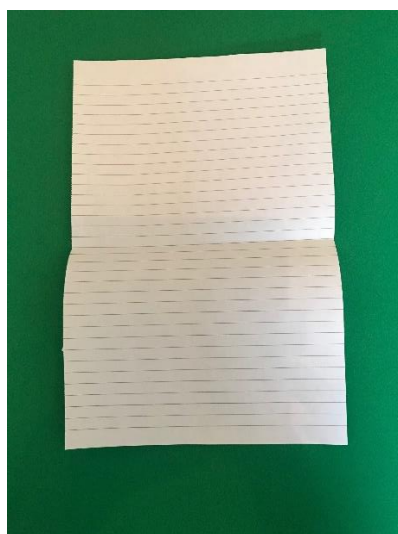




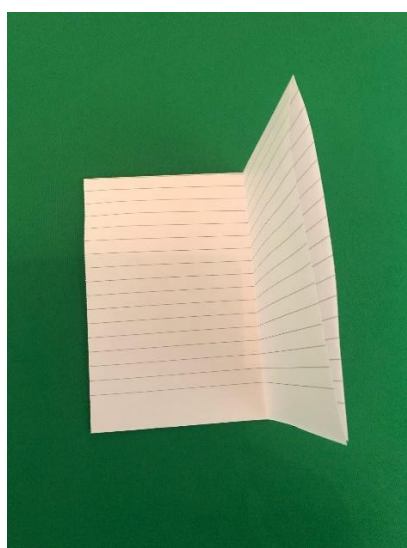
An easy origami boat

(If all else fails, take a deep breath and just draw a picture of a boat.)

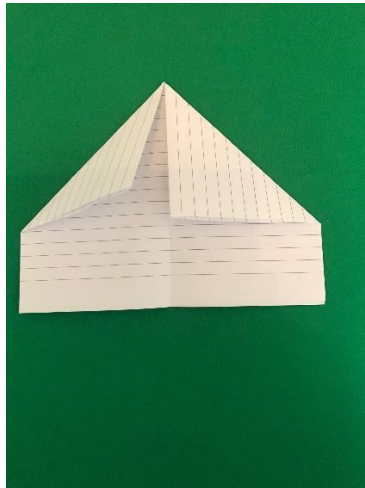
1 Take a piece of rectangular paper and fold in half from top to bottom.



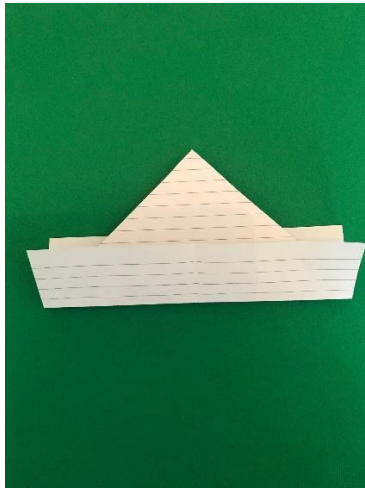
2. Keep it folded and fold it in half again, side to side.



3. Go for a hat shape by opening the most recent fold, then making a triangle with a 'brim'



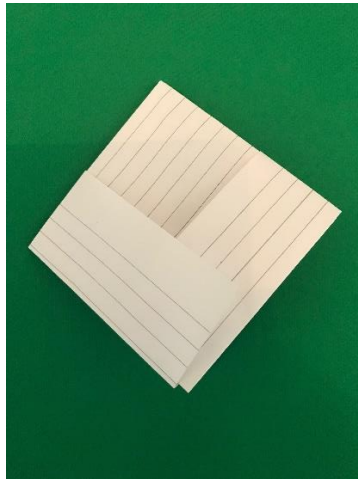
4. Fold up the 'brim' on one side, then turn over the paper and fold up the other. You can wear this if you feel the need.



5. Now put your thumbs inside the hat shape and pull it into a flat square.



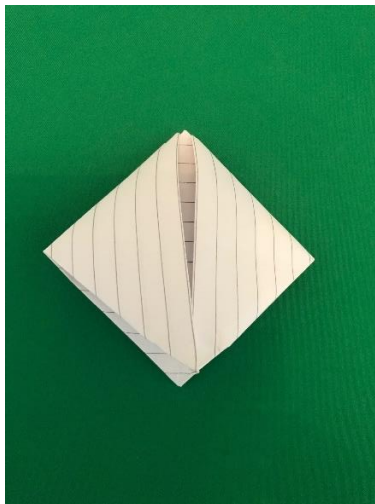
6. Tuck in the sticky-outy corners.



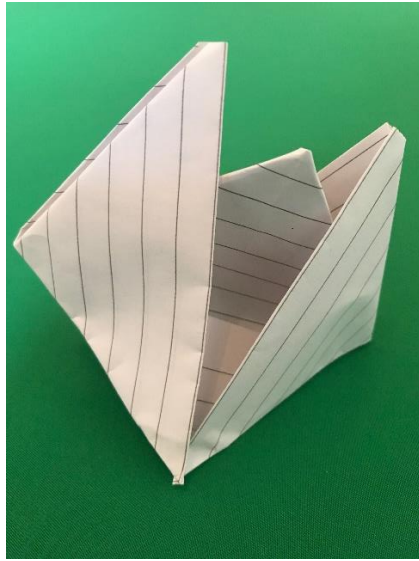
7. Fold up the bottom corner to meet the top on one side to form a triangle, then turn the paper over and fold up the other side to mirror the first.



8. Thumbs into the open side and pull it into a flat square again.



9. Hold tight to the top corner on each side and gently but masterfully pull them apart.



10. Ta da – your boat appears after a little artful squishing. Congratulations.
